- We shall ensure that all activities are carried out in accordance with State, National OHS and Mining Statutory Legislation requirements and best practice as exemplified in relevant Australian Standards and Codes of Practice.
- We shall also comply with the Safety Contractual Obligations and Corporate Policies of our clients.
- All Employees and Sub-contractors share responsibility and accountability with management in ensuring the safe wellbeing of themselves and other persons in the workplace. Reporting any unsafe substandard acts or conditions immediately so these can be addressed.
- Central Queensland Exploration Pty Ltd neither expects nor requires our Employees or Sub-contractors to attempt any work place activity that could have the potential to cause them harm.
- Actively promote and development Risk Management Techniques and Procedures and the identification and control of these hazards through elimination of these risks and if elimination is not possible then to manage the level of the risk to as low as reasonably achievable.
- Maintain and review our Safety Management Plan and Operating Procedure on a regular basis.
